



COVID-19 Dashboard Update Announcement

March 17, 2021 - Today, the North of Superior Health Care Group (NOSH) and North Shore Family Health Team (NSFHT), are reporting one (1) new positive case of COVID-19 in our communities.

One of the new positive cases in our community has been identified as a NOSH employee. Currently, NOSH is completing an in-depth internal contact tracing and any close contacts are required to self-isolate. At this time, there is no changes to patients scheduled appointments or visitation and the risk to any staff or patients remains low.

Thunder Bay District Health Unit (TBDHU) will continue to complete thorough contact tracing and will identify any high-risk close contacts. If you believe you are a close contact of anyone who has tested positive for COVID-19, please self-isolate until you are given specific instructions by the TBDHU.
